A review of Mr. Herman Cain's medical history by R. Martin York, M.D.:

Mr. Cain underwent a colonoscopy in early 2006 after experiencing some lower abdominal discomfort in early January. The colonoscopy was diagnostic for colon carcinoma. A subsequent CT Scan and MRI also revealed three metastatic liver lesions. Mr. Cain was seen for medical oncology consultation by Dr. York in April 2006. Treatment recommendations and planning included a referral to MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas for a second opinion and further evaluation.

Mr. Cain returned home to Atlanta where he was treated with four cycles of neo-adjuvant chemotherapy consisting of Avastin, Oxaliplatin, 5-FU and Leucovorin (aFOLFOX regimen). He tolerated the chemotherapy quite well. In August 2006, he had subsequent surgery to remove the lesions from the liver and the primary colon cancer at MD Anderson Cancer Center. All liver lesions were successfully resected with clear margins. Of the 47 lymph nodes sampled, all were negative for cancer.

Following surgery, he was treated with six additional cycles of aFOLFOX chemotherapy which he tolerated well and completed in January 2007.

Mr. Cain has been seen by Dr. York annually for follow-up and evaluation. He has remained cancer free for the last five years as evidenced by the most recent CT scan of the Chest/Abdomen/Pelvis on July 20, 2011. Mr. Cain represents a success story in the treatment of colon cancer.
