METHODOLOGY:

The sample size for the survey is 618 Active Voters taken from a listed sample of registered voters who have voted in the 2010 or 2012 general elections, or registered since the 2012 general election. The margin of error is +/- 3.9 %. 469 interviews were completed using automated telephone technology and 149 were conducted using mobile based survey technology. All interviews were conducted April 28-30, 2014 by Vox Populi Polling. The total percentages for responses may not equal 100% due to rounding.
